FINANCIAL AID. Choosing to invest in a private school education is one of the most important decisions you will make for your child. Annual tuition rate is established in late spring. For financial aid Notre Dame follows a "cost-based/ needs-based" financial aid program. Families apply for financial aid through FACTS, a third party entity that considers each family's individual financial situation. Based on the information provided, FACTS calculates the family's financial award. Approximately sixty-six percent of our Notre Dame families received financial aid for the 2018-19 school year. To determine financial aid, a complete application for admission must be submitted to Notre Dame. Upon student acceptance to Notre Dame, families who have completed the FACTS financial aid application will receive a financial aid determination letter. In an effort to tailor financial assistance for each family, Notre Dame is committed to providrepresentative, chosen by the Board of Trustees, to meet with each first-time family applying through FACTS. The representative will review the FACTS results, discuss any concerns and extenuating circumstances, and help with any necessary appeal.






